



## Q20 - What is your age?





Q5 - Do you identify as an evangelical Christian?





Q2 - Are you a registered voter?
















Q10 - Do you believe same-sex marriage should be legal?





Q11 - Do you believe abortion should be legal?





**Q12 - How important is the issue of income inequality to you?**





**Q13 - Do you believe that action should be taken to address the effects of the growing levels of income inequality in America?**







**Q15 - What do you estimate to be the average political views of the leadership of your church?**









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**Q18 - Do you feel that the actions of believers can make a significant difference on the effects of income inequality?**




